### **☆ Object of the Trust:**

The main mission of the trust is to carry out the overall development of the Dang district (totally, a backward area with a population of 2.26 lakh people out of which 98 per cent is tribal in 311 villages). The Trust object is to render & support for every aspect of human, social and commercial development, improvement of healthcare, education, literacy, etc. - etc. without discriminations of caste, color, gender or race and community. Development in area include housing, development of agriculture, horticulture, forest, industry, business trade and commerce with the purpose of making the population indigenious, self sufficient, progressive and prosperous.

Trust execute and implement the various schemes/projects and activities of the Government of India and Government of Gujarat and other schemes sponsored by international organizations and agencies, for the development of Dang and its people.

The trust shall specially devote itself for women's development and empowerment.

The trust determination mainly aimed at elimination of poverty through Micro Credit, Micro banking, providing shelters, education and guidance implementation of Agricultural / horticultural activities etc. - etc. with special focus for the District Dang.

Rovadan trust have undertaken following community development projects during the year: 2015-16.

**A) AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS FOR FARMERS:**

Under agricultural development projects, we have undertaken the following projects (Table 1). This included 84 villages of 1072 beneficiaries and covered 972 acre of land. The details of these projects are as under.

## 1. Yam project :

This project was implemented in 3 villages of the Dangs districts. Total 34 numbers of farmers were the parts of the project. The main aim of this project was crop improvement and transfer of technology for better crop production and increase income of farmers. Meeting and training to farmers at village level was given by technical staff and simultaneously, kit distribution (seed and fertilizer) was done.

The project was support by Tribal area sub plan under Horticultural Department. In this project total 8.5 Acre areas were covered. With the help of this project farmers are able to know the crop cultivation practices for future crop production.



## 2. Drumstick project:

The project was undertaken in the dangs district and covered 4 villages of 50 farmers. The main object of this project is crop diversification with more production of biomass and increase the income of farmers. Total area covered in this project was 25 acre.



The project was supported by Tribal area sub plan under Horticultural Department.

This project provided the additional income to farmers.

### **3. Pineapple project :**

This project was undertaken on pilot bases in first time in the Dang district for diversification and improvement of income of farmers.



In this project, we have selected 17 no. of beneficiaries from ten villages of Dang district and covered area about one acre. This project was sanctioned by Tribal Area Sub Plan-Ahwa under the guidance of horticultural department.

The planting of pineapple sapling is done in the month of January in farmers' field. Trust has supplied required number of sapling to farmers in 250mt<sup>2</sup> area and other input kits supplied to farmers like Chemical fertilizer, Organic fertilizer and plant protection material to selected beneficiaries.

### **4. Strawberry project :**

This project was implemented in nine villages of Dang district with total 18 nos. of beneficiary in September 2016 in 10 (1000 mt<sup>2</sup>) guntha area for better production and increase the income of farmers. The required numbers of runners for planting (4450 No)

and organic fertilizer and inorganic fertilizer with plant protection material were distributed to farmers. The trust has also given training on advanced technology of cultivation practices. The growth and development of plant were found good. Farmers have sold strawberry fruits in local market. Tribal Area Sub Plan-Ahwa sanctioned this project & trust also help in marketing strawberry fruits in remote market so the farmers get good returns of their produced. Average farmers have earn Rs. 25000/- from ten guntha plot area.



## **B . Skill training project:**

### **Medical Community Attendance (Patient attendance) Training**

We had implemented this programme in Dang district since 2004. This training was supported by Govt. More than 70% trainees were on job at various hospitals and clinics near Dang district. Patient attendance training programme has been conceptualized considering the first point of van bandhu kalyan yojana. Rovadan Trust has been implementing this programme in dang district. Due to non availability of employment opportunities other than agriculture sector and lack of skill, most of people are Unemployed and thus in search of livelihood.



In this year Patient Attendance Training is given to 30 tribal girls of Dang district who have at least passed Standard 12 (HSC) examination. This training was started in the month of August 2015 & it will be completed in May 2016.

To conduct Patient Attendance Training Programme; Rovadan trust has already recruited well experienced instructors to run this training programme. This is ten months full time residential training course. During this period, they learn theory and undergo practical work at Civil Hospital, Ahwa-Dangs. Trainees also visit PHCs and serve in the pulse polio, blood donation & health camps. These trainees are well aware of importance and functions of hospital like Emergency (ICU), Surgical, Gynec, O.P.D, Medicine (OPD), Injection (OPD), Pulse Polio, Laboratory, Medical, Operation Theater and Post mortems. At the end of the training programme, these trainees have one month placement at L. G. Hariya Rotary Hospital, Vapi where they come across various practical aspects. Our 70.00% trainees of previous year batch were placed in well known hospitals, clinics and government projects.



## PROJECT FOR AGRICULTURAL DEMOSTRATION:

### Nursery project:

The trust runs 8 acres of demonstration farms for farmers at Bhavandagad. Where different crops are grown scientifically with modern agro techniques for demonstration of farmers *i.e.* agronomic practices are displayed in the field, such as date of sowing, crop spacing and method of sowing, uses of organic and inorganic fertilizer (method, time and amount of fertilizer) and irrigation practices (how to apply, when to apply and how much to apply) and harvesting methods etc. This year, we have undertaken a different crop demonstration *i.e.* Nagli, paddy, Kharsani (Niger), okra, tomato and maize at nursery farm. Bring farmers from remote villages of Dang and demonstrated them about improved method of crop cultivations. Farmers of Dangs District has visited the demonstration plot and learned about the package of practices of different crops. It also employs several tribal people of Bhavandagad village and other surrounding villages. The total project cost is Rs 200000/-
