Darpan Inani (born in 1994) lost his eyesight at the age of 3. His family refused admission to a special school and demanded quality education at a regular school with his peers. Darpan gave all his exams on a computer with the help of screen reading software and consistently scored above 90% ranking in the top 3 students of the class. In 2015, he received an offer from IIM Lucknow for a MBA which he declined to pursue CA and his career in chess. Today, Darpan is the highest rated blind chess player in India. It was the willingness of the school and the teachers to go the extra mile that allowed Darpan to reach his true potential.
