Full fledge classes on the following trades with student strength of 20 nos. has started from the 1<sup>st</sup> of August:

- Commencing the eighth month of its functioning students at Prayas Skill Development Center has progressed in the respective field of studies and is aiming industry exposure. In this regards the remaining duration of the program will include more of industrial visits.





As part of life skills classes we are imparting certain skills to all students required for basic living. This includes Functional reading starting from alphabet recognition and formation, picture reading and picture comprehension. Students are given knowledge of basic cooking, physical fitness, basic computer skills, Functional money. To improve Fine motor skills (FMS) and eye-hand coordination, students are making Rangoli's every day.





To give practical exposure, students are taken to field trips and visits. They celebrated “Patangotsav” organized by Sandesh Newspaper. They enjoyed the festival and learnt to socialize. They also visited VNSGU for art Exhibition, Reliance Mart.

(a) Basic course in computer Operations & Data Entry:



Students have started with alphabet and symbol recognition on key-board, functions of keys, mouse gripping and typing.

Kaniz Fathima and Rajbhara has completed ‘MS Word’ and started with ‘MS Excel’. They are ready for placement in front office related jobs.

(b) Basic course in Electronics and Electricals :



Identification of tools used in electricals. They have been taught to identify wires, testers, screw-drivers, cutter, switches, etc. Repairing of household equipment is a field where every student shows great interest and improvement.

Aayush patel and Raj Aahir are working practically in repairing and wiring. They are already in the field assisting professional wiremen and electricians.

(c) Basic Course in Embroidery & Cloth Bag Manufacturing :



Kaniz Fathima, Rajbhara and Sivani Nahak are improving in the measurement skills. Students are cutting and stitching basic sample frocks, gowns and skirts. They are involved in bag making and



thread bangle making along with this, other students have started with hand stitching and buttoning.

(d) Basic Course in Martial Art :



Students started martial arts training with running, basic warm up. They are improving with flexibility exercises, stamina and other techniques.

Almash patel and Bilal saiyaad are acquiring skills with proficiency students are shown videos and live matches to get knowledge of the trades.

(e) Basic course in Terrace Gardening :



Students got engaged in making bed soil using mud & compost. Later they planted seeds of seasonal vegetables. They grew spinach, cared & harvested, later they cooked palak, theplas. Students also visiting various terrace gardens to have an idea of their trade. For natural
