Report of Visit at Osmosis Play Centre and Educational Games Library Trust, Bharuch on 13th January, 2016

About Foundation:

- 1. Osmosis centre and Education Games Library was set up in 2010 as a charitable trust under Bombay Public Charitable Trust Act.
- 2. They provide basic subject knowledge along with therapies which includes Remedial Therapy/ Play Therapy, Clinical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Sensory Integration, Psychological Testing IQ, Interest and Aptitude and the facility of Educational Games Library.
- 3. The target group of Special Children (**Divyang**) is in the age group of 2 years to 15 years with Learning Difficulties (Dyslexia, Dysgraphia and Dyscalculia), Autistic, Down Syndrome, Slow Learner, Cerebral Palsy, Attention Deficit Hyperactive Disorder etc.
- 4. They have 12 Nos. of teaching staff (Masters in Psychology) and 7 Nos. of part time teachers (B.Com and House Wives)
- 5. Total 69 students in Osmosis Centre and Education Games Library Trust.
- 6. Support received for centre from GNFC, GACL, G-Enterprises, Tobacco Wala Foundation (Bombay), Godrej Foundation and Private Donors.
- 7. Fees received from parents depend on their economic condition.
- 8. Student Teacher Ratio is 1:1. With children with Learning Difficulties, at the same level, the teacher student ratio can be 1:3.
- 9. As far as the children's progress is concerned the teachers will give a 3 monthly report. The report will be discussed by parents and school teachers.
- 10. A detailed Progress Report will be shared with the sponsoring organization every quarter.

About Trustees:

Shree Subhash Bhagwat Associated with Adarsh Pragati Mandal, Morakhala which runs a secondary school for Adivasi Children in Chhotaudepur District for the last ten years, have been associated with Osmosis since inception.
