Consortium for inclusive education (CIE) is a Deepak Foundation initiative supported by Gujarat CSR authority and established in October 2018. It is dedicated to building an inclusive society, and that begins with inclusive education for children with disabilities.

Objective: The event aims to provide teachers with a platform to build new innovative teaching and learning material (TLM), demonstrate their skills and learn different and better ways to educate all children including children with disabilities (CwDs). It aims to build a resource library of TLMs collected through this event in Sankul.

The event took place in two phases, first was the competition and the second phase was the exhibition of the TLM received for the competition.

Competition: All schools were requested to nominate at least two teachers. The participants were asked to submit material relevant to 4th to 6th grade children from Language (English or Gujarati), Mathematics or Science courses. The criteria for competition was that the material should be enough to cover a 20 to 30 mins class and should be accessible by children with at least one of the following types of disabilities: learning disabilities, autism spectrum disorder, visual impairment, attention deficit and hyperactive disorder, and hearing and speech impairment. The deadline for the submission was August 16th, 2019.

The consortium received a total of 50 TLMs from 12 schools and NGOs. Following panelist were identified to review the material on the day of the exhibition:

1. Ms Nivisha Shah, Inclusive Education and Disabilities Consultant
2. MsShrutiBhargava, expert in early intervention, Sehar – eknaiudaan
3. MsVimalThawani, expert in special needs education, blind peoples association

Exhibition: The exhibition took place on Saturday 20th August 2019 at Samaj Suraksha Sankul. On the day of the exhibition, all the participating teachers were divided into 6 rooms categorized by the three subjects i.e. Language, Mathematics and Science. In addition to the TLM exhibition rooms, three additional rooms were set-up for the visitors. One room was dedicated as a simulation room, where visitors got an opportunity to experience the world through a person with disabilities eyes. The other two rooms showcased assistive technology and tools for children with visual impairment and children with invisible disabilities. The resources showcased in the technology and tools came from Sankul School and Recourse Center, Early Intervention Center at Sankul, Saher, and Blind People's Association.

The event was concluded with the award ceremony where prize distribution took place. Following were the winners for TLM competition:
